

2019-2020 GHUCCTS TBS Grant Writing Workshop (for predoctoral students, postdoctoral fellows and early stage career investigators)

Objective: Each participant will develop, revise, and prepare to submit an F-, K-, or R-series NIH grant application, or equivalent over the course of this in-person workshop with constructive input from facilitators and participants. Participants will hone their grant writing skills through attending lectures on best practices for individual grant components and by giving and receiving constructive feedback from their peers.

Format:

- Facilitators discuss grant application components, illustrating best practices with good and bad examples
- Participants provide constructive feedback for assigned draft applications during discussion sessions

Requirements:

- Submission of proposal drafts to the TBS GWW Box Folder
- Full participation at a minimum of four out of five peer review discussion sessions
- Attendance at a minimum of five out of six talks
- Bring laptops to peer review workshops
