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Through the HEAL initiative, NIH supports research to enhance pain management and improve treatment for opioid misuse and addiction. To that end, the NIH will re-release RFA-NS-19-021 (UG3/UH3) on January 20, 2020 with an expected submission deadline on <u>March 24, 2020</u>. Through this re-release, HEAL Initiative: Pain Management Multi-site Effectiveness Research Network (ERN): Clinical Trial Planning and Implementation Cooperative Agreement (UG3/UH3 Clinical Trial Required), NIH is soliciting up to two additional ERN trials that will address specific high priorities.
