BMORA – Bio-demographic Models of Reproductive Aging	Maxine Weinstein	5-year longitudinal study of female reproductive aging that includes hormonal, menstrual cycle, and health data from a diverse group of 750 women 25-58 years
SEBAS – Social Environmental and Biomarkers of Aging	Maxine Weinstein	Self-reports of physical, psychological, and social well-being, plus extensive clinical and lab data from Asian men and women
HIV Studies	Frank Wong	Cohort of Asian Men in DC followed for HIV treatment and complications

Family Genetics Study of Prostate Cancer	Georgia Dunstan	103 African American pedigrees with a minimum of 4 affect with prostate cancer. Data from blood samples of 790 individuals from 98 families. Genome wide markers for linkage studies
Memory Disorder Study	T Obisesan	Study of 1700 African Americans to examine the effect of PA on memory function
Obesity in African Americans	Otelio Randall	215 obese African Americans. Data contains baseline & 6 month hemodynamic & cardiac measures. 24-hr ambulatory BP & HR data

African-American Study of Kidney Disease and Hypertension (AASK Study)	Otelio Randall	Multicenter study of 10904 African American non-diabetics to evaluate the impact of BP control on the progression of hypertensive kidney disease. Data include lipid profile, kidney function, CVD outcomes.
Howard/Hopkins Center for Reducing Asthma Disparities – Human Genetics Project	Georgia Dunstan	100 African American asthmatics recruited. Lung function. DNA extracted candidate genes genotyped.

Strong Heart Study – CVD and Diabetes in American Indians	Barbara Howard	4500 American Indian men and women 45-74 yrs followed for 19 years and 3600 >age 15 from 97 extended families; biomarkers, genetic map and SNPs

VA Health Care Data Repository	Richard Amdur	Contains vital sign readings in all VA pts, beginning in 2000. inc demographic, surgical and outcome data
VA DSS Database	Richard Amdur	Contains diagnostic codes, lab results, med prescriptions, and cost of care, for all VA inpatient & outpatient encounters beginning 2001.
NISQIP Database	Richard Amdur	VA database of all VA surgeries since 2000, including demographic, surgical, and outcome data.
National Pacemaker Center Database	Richard Amdur	Data on mortality/morbidity for all pacemakers & defibrillators implanted since 1995 in the US
