



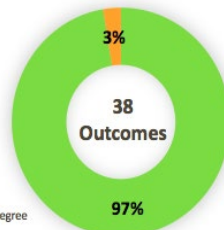

GRADUATE PLACEMENT

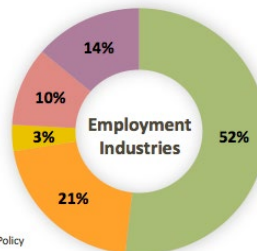
